Per the direction of the staff reviewing this report, not allocated revenues were reduced by the same amount. Contributions to endowments were approximately $\$ 1.3 \mathrm{M}$. Changes in seat related gift programs and timing resulted in an increase in contributions of approximately $\$ 2.75 \mathrm{M}$. All contribution amounts related to seating in venues are reported by sport. Any related expenditures beyond the operation of the seating area are reported as unallocated. MSU had 7 home football games during 2011-12. MSU had 9 teams and individuals from 8 other teams compete in NCAA championships. The football team participated in the inaugural Big Ten Championship game and the Outback Bowl. Menâ $€^{\text {TM }}$ s basketball also participated in the inaugural Carrier Classic in San Diego.
